## Misc. Information

Phone Use: CELL PHONES are allowed at school but are to be TURNED OFF when arriving in the morning until the end of the school day. Please make arrangements for transportation, etc., with your student before school to alleviate the need for the phone to be used. If a student feels ill, they need to come to the office. They need to be authorized by staff to call or text from their cell phone and should not call or text from a classroom or bathroom.

**Planners:** Each student will be provided with daily planner to keep in their binders to be used for the school year. The Student Handbook and other valuable information are included in this document. Students are expected to keep track of assignments in this planner and share this information with their parents.

**Online Registration and Student Information Update:** Please ensure you have completed the on-line registration process on the Aeries parent portal (information to be sent on August 1 from Mr. Rene Buenrostro). Aeries is the student database where attendance and report card can be accessed. Aeries is also where parents update contact information. The portal will be open on August 1st to all parents to update personal contacts, address changes, and emergency contact information. **Riding Bikes/scooters to School:** A bike rack is available for students near the front office. Students must provide their own locks. By law, students who ride bikes need to wear a helmet. Please walk bikes while on campus and park bikes in the rack rather than against fences. Skateboards are not allowed at school and should not be used to ride to or from school.

**Schedule Changes:** Administration may make some required schedule changes as we start the year. The changes will be made with the least disruption possible to the student schedules. These changes will take place in the first few weeks or so of school as enrollment solidifies. We will not be able to make schedule changes based on requests for particular teachers or a particular order of classes. Thank you for your patience and understanding. **Absent Students:** Attendance is one of the key factors in your child being successful in school and maximizing our funding from the state. Please consult the attached school calendar that can also be found on our website when planning vacations and making appointments. If your student is absent, please call the school to notify the school of the absence and the reason – (530) 672-4400. If you do not contact us, the absence may be unexcused.

**Checking Students Out of School:** If you need to check your student out of school before the end of the school day, you will need to come into the office to sign your student out. Whenever possible, please send a note with your student so that they can leave class at the appropriate time. This will cut down on the time required for us to send a student aide to retrieve them. Your student will be called to the office when a parent/guardian arrives at the office and not prior.

**Drop Off and Pick-up:** There are many parents who drive their children to and from school. In order to make drop off and pick up as timely and safe as possible, please allow extra time for the inevitable traffic on Green Valley Road. Please follow all signs and the flow of traffic. Students should be ready to exit the car upon pulling up to the sidewalk in front of the school. Please remind students to look both ways if they are crossing through the parking lot. Please never allow students to exit car on a red curb. This is not legal and backs up traffic.

**Grade Level Policies and Supply Lists:** Teachers will email out all required supplies & class grading information. We are an AVID school and students will be required to stay organized and have regular binder organization checks. All students are required to have a binder with the following items/tools for success in them on a daily basis. Fully stocked AVID Binders will be for sale at the Puma Walk for a \$15 donation. If you need support with the supplies, please let the school know so we can assist.

**Immunization Information for Parents of 7th Grade Students:** California state law requires that all students entering 7th grade show proof that they received **TWO Varicella** immunizations and one **Tdap** booster (after age seven) before they are allowed to start school. In addition, a personal belief exemption is no longer valid for students entering the 7th grade. All students entering 7th grade must be fully immunized or have a written medical exemption from their doctor for any immunizations. Please email or bring your child's updated immunization record to the school office as soon as possible.

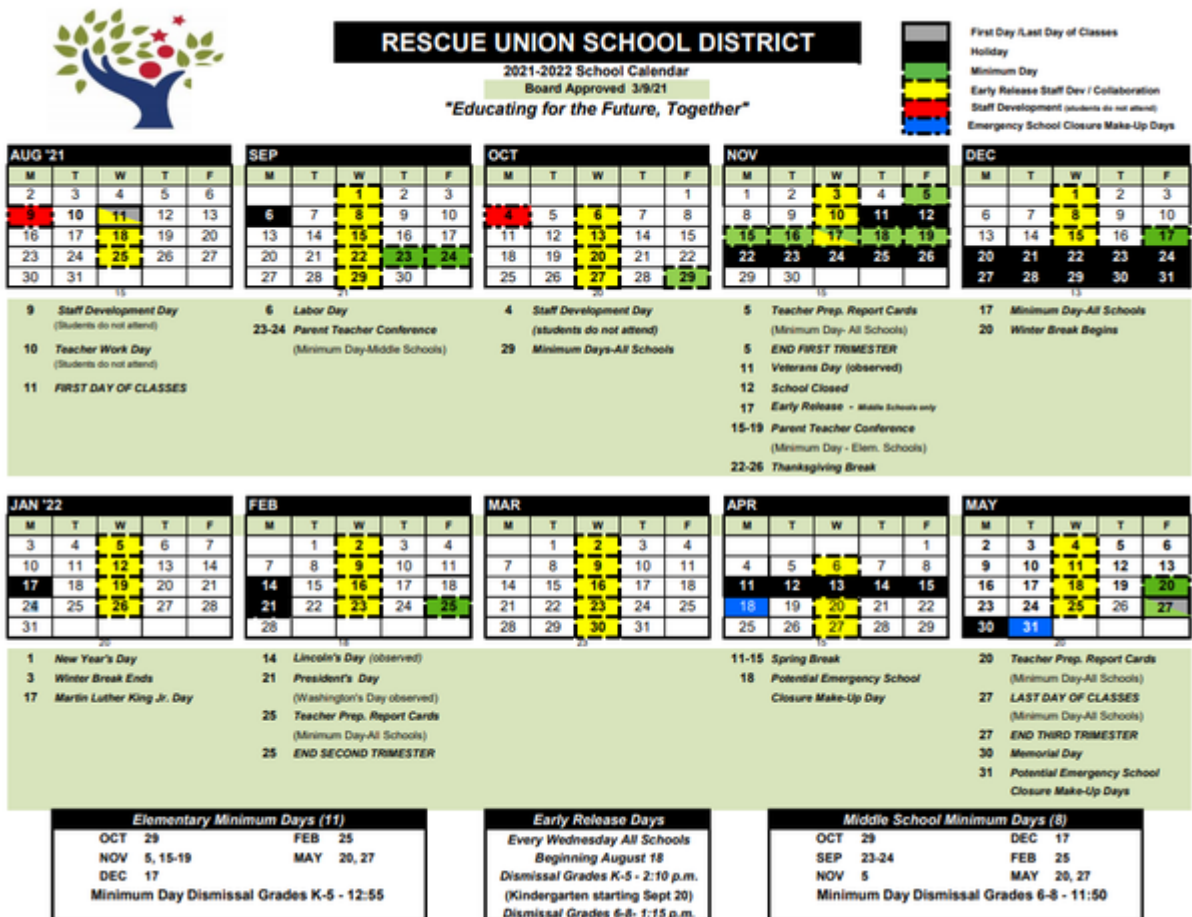

# Superintendent Jim Shoemake's Message to Parents (Mask update paragraph 3)

(Message Sent to Parents July 21st)

## Rescue Union School District

Dear Rescue Union School District Community,

We hope that all of you are enjoying a great summer break with family and friends. Hopefully you have had a chance to get away for a few days and enjoy some cooler weather somewhere. During the month of June, we were able to hold our RISE Summer School program supporting over 400 students. We are currently holding our BOOST Summer School program supporting over 100 students. Students and staff have enjoyed this experience receiving great academic support and opportunities for socialization. If your child was able to take advantage of these programs, we hope they had a good time while learning with their friends.

Our District staff have been working hard this summer preparing for the 2021-22 school year. We have had the opportunity to hire several new staff members and we are excited to add them to our team. We are also still accepting enrollment applications for the 2021-22 school year. If you still need to register your student, please stop by our District Office during the hours of 8:00a.m. - 4:00p.m. as soon as possible as our school offices are scheduled to open on July, 28, 2021.

We are aware that families are closely watching the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidelines that are being released concerning the opening of the school year and particularly regarding the use of masks. CDPH put out their initial guidelines on June 15, 2021, but they have already been updated several times since then. Currently, the guidelines are requiring that students and staff will not be required to wear masks outdoors, but will be required to wear them indoors regardless of vaccination status.

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It is the desire of our Board and our District for all students to be able to attend a clean and safe school and for masks to be optional for our students and staff. However, we are committed to following the law and regulations provided to us. We are exploring every option possible to create time and space on campuses where our students and staff can be mask free.



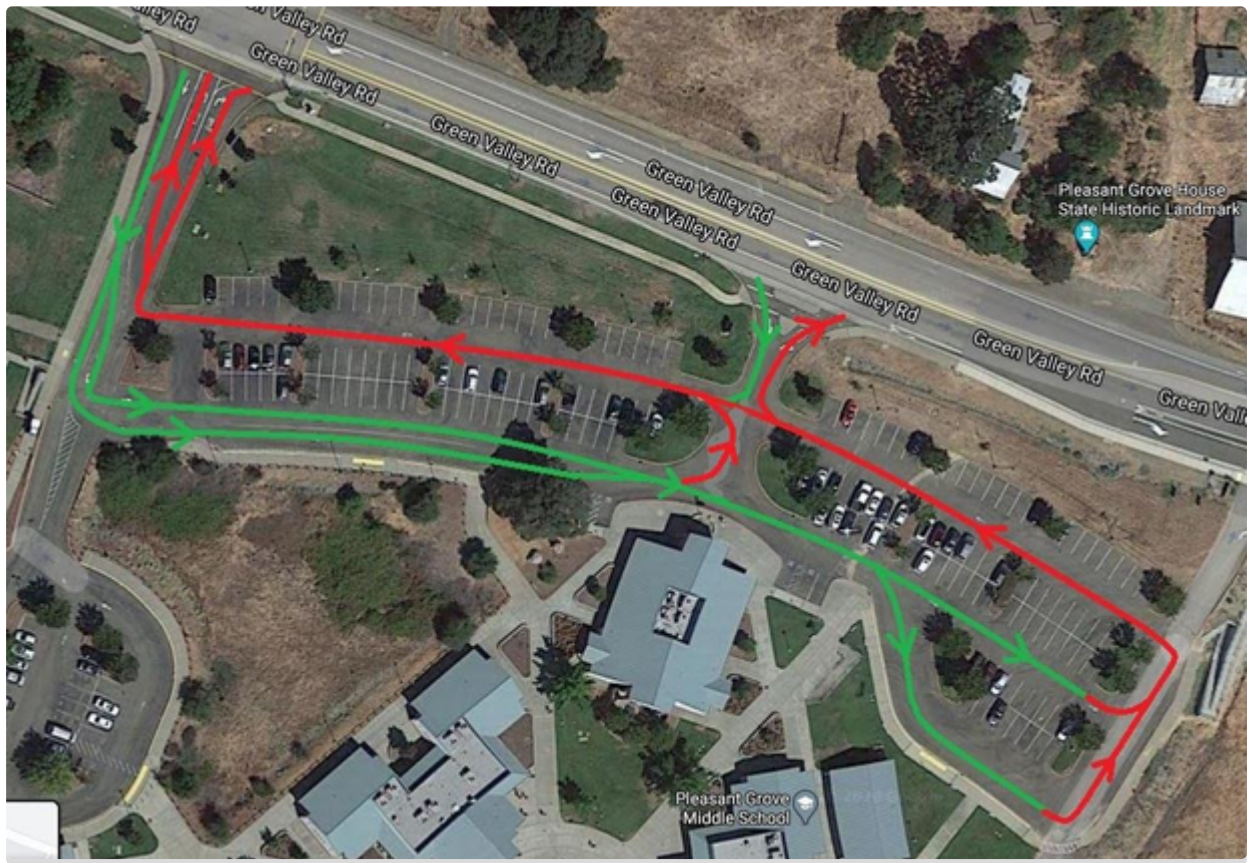

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## Parking Lot Flow of Traffic & Procedures

- 1) Vehicles can either exit onto Green Valley with a right turn or exit at the stop light to turn left or right.
  - 2) Vehicles that use the center lane in front of the office will need to turn left when clear of oncoming entrance traffic, and exit the lot at the stop light.
  - 3) Vehicles entering the parking lot in the center lane will need to turn right upon entrance. No straight through traffic permitted.
  - 4) Students need to be ready to exit vehicle upon their turn in the parking lot line. No exiting on a red curb or parking on red curbs. This will help the flow of traffic.
